Our baby area



Our baby area is a calm, nurturing space designed with natural tones and gentle resources to help little ones feel safe and settled from their very first day.

Children can explore role play with a beautiful wooden play kitchen, baskets of hats and handbags, curl up in our cosy reading corner, or discover new textures each day with our sensory tuff tray activities. When it's time to rest, a peaceful sleep area with cots is tucked behind soft curtains – giving babies the comfort of quiet while still feeling close by.

Our open-plan design means babies can see into the toddler room, helping them feel curious and confident about their next steps when the time comes to transition. Most importantly, our experienced staff take time to get to know each baby's individual routine – from feeds to naps to cuddles – so that their day feels like a natural extension of home.

Our toddler area



Our toddler room is full of natural resources and cosy spaces, designed to spark curiosity while helping little ones feel safe and at home.

Children love role play in our shop and wooden kitchen, getting creative with playdough and crafts, or curling up in the reading corner with soft pillows and blankets. The reading area is also where nap time takes place – with mattresses and individual sheets and blankets so every child has their own special set.

We gently encourage toddlers to follow the daily rhythm of the room – with mealtimes, snacks, song time, story time and naps giving structure to their day.

An open-plan view into the preschool room helps children feel curious and confident about the next step in their journey.

And of course, our toddlers enjoy plenty of outdoor play in our two garden spaces, where they can explore nature, make discoveries, and burn off energy in the fresh air.

Our Preschool room



Our preschool room is a bright, inspiring space filled with natural resources that encourage independence, curiosity and creativity.

Children can explore role play in the kitchen in fancy dress to act out their own stories. The art area is always ready for little makers – fully stocked with paints, crayons, ribbons, buttons, stickers and more.

Small world play sparks imagination with dinosaurs, dolls' houses, farms, and underwater creatures – while the maths area offers hands-on resources like scales, jigsaws and shapes to build problem-solving skills

A cosy reading area with a sofa, cushions and thoughtful toys supports children's emotional wellbeing and self-regulation, giving them space to relax, reflect and connect with stories.

Snack and meal times take place in the dining area – also the hub for baking activities, where children can mix, pour and taste their creations.

Children enjoy direct access to our one of our outdoor areas, where they can dive into water play, mud kitchen fun and all sorts of messy play adventures.

Our staff gently guide children through a familiar daily rhythm – with song time, small group activities and story time – to help them feel confident, capable and prepared for their exciting next step into primary school.

Starting out and settling in

We understand that starting nursery can feel like a big step – for both you and your child. That's why our settling-in procedure is designed to make this transition gentle, supportive and reassuring every step of the way.

From the very beginning, our aim is to help your child feel safe, secure and excited about their new environment – and to help you feel confident and at ease too.

During your visit you will meet one of our managers who will show you the whole setting and will be able to answer any questions that you may have. At the end of this visit you will be given a paper copy of the registration documents or these will be emailed to you.

If you decide that Bright Beginnings is the right setting for your child, you will complete the registration forms given and return them to our office manager via email brightbeginningsofficemanager@gmail.com

You will be sent an invoice for a registration fee of £70. The invoice will contain instructions of how to pay. Once this fee has been received your child's place at the nursery is secured.

5

Your child will be invited to attend for two 1 hour settling in sessions (free of charge) about a week before their start date. In your child's first couple of weeks with us, we will select a Key Worker for them.

Mealtimes at Bright Beginnings are an important part of each child's day – not just for nourishment, but for learning, independence and community.

Our experienced cook, Lisa, prepares healthy meals and snacks on site in our 5-star food hygiene rated kitchen. Each day, children enjoy freshly cooked, balanced food to give them the energy they need to learn and play.

We work closely with families to cater for any allergies, intolerances or dietary needs. All staff are fully informed and remain vigilant to ensure every child is safe and included. Sometimes, the children even bake their own desserts – adding a sprinkle of fun and creativity to the menu.

As children grow, we gently encourage them to use proper plates, cups and cutlery, and to serve themselves at mealtimes. This helps them develop independence, make their own choices, and discover their food preferences.

Fees & Funding

FUNDING

At Bright Beginnings, we accept government funded childcare places. Depending on your family circumstances and the age of your child, you may be entitled to 15 or 30 hours government funding towards your childcare costs. For more information about how many hours funding you are entitled to, please visit <https://www.gov.uk/sign-in-childcare-account>.

Government funding is intended to deliver 15-30 hours a week of funded childcare, during term time. Our setting is open all year round (51 weeks of the year) and therefore we stretch the funding to cover this. 30 hours term time funding then becomes 22 hours per week, and 15 hours term time funding becomes 11 hours per week. A maximum of 10 hours can be used per day, and a minimum of 2 days per week. The funding is not intended to cover the cost of food or Additional Services, therefore Bright Beginnings charges a £18.50 fee per day for government funded days. You can use your government funded sessions and also pay for additional sessions if you require them.

ADDITIONAL SERVICES

At Bright Beginnings, we go beyond the EYFS curriculum to give children experiences that spark curiosity and joy. Through trips to Hull Museums, Ferens Art Gallery, parks, The Deep, the marina, and the library, children explore the world with confidence. During these trips we offer a higher staff ratios for your peace of mind. Our extra activities include Debutots storytelling and drama, sessions in the gym studio, and hands-on fun with baking and gardening. We celebrate cultural and religious festivals, plus playful events like Bee Day and our summer festival, helping every child feel connected and inspired. Extra opportunities like tennis and swimming lessons are available at an additional cost.

TAX FREE CHILDCARE

You may be entitled to Tax Free childcare. You will need to create an account on this website to access this and you can pay Bright Beginnings directly from the website. Tax free childcare can save you about 20% off your childcare costs.

FEES

If you are not using government funding the fees for Bright Beginnings are:

- £70 per day (7.30am-6pm)
- £60 per short day (8.30am-4pm)
